<p>WHY</p> 	<p>It is estimated 1 in 300 school-aged children suffer an undiagnosed heart defect, which can lead to sudden cardiac arrest and death. A typical annual physical does not screen for advanced heart abnormalities. <p>WHAT</p> 	<p>Screenings take 60-90 minutes (wait times may vary) and include a health history questionnaire review, an EKG test, and an echocardiogram. The entire process is non-invasive—no needles or x-ray exposure—and we ensure each teen’s confidentiality, privacy and individual modesty is respected throughout all aspects of the screening.</p>	<p>COST</p> 	<p>OUR SCREENINGS ARE OFFERED FREE OF CHARGE thanks to our sponsors.
