Why Businesses Need AEDs



Sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) can strike anyone, anytime. Every year in the U.S., over 350,000 people experience out-of-hospital cardiac arrest—around 10,000 per year occur in the workplace.

More than 50% of people cannot locate an AED at work, and 55% of workers do not get CPR and AED training from their employer. This means that the majority of employees do not know when an AED is nearby or that it is a valuable tool that anyone can use to save a life.



The only effective treatment for SCA is immediate CPR and defibrillation.



Every minute counts—survival chances drop by 10% for every minute without defibrillation, and brain damage can begin within 8 minutes. With an average EMS response time of 7 minutes or more, having an AED on-site is critical.

The average amount of time spent in the workplace per day is around 8 hours.



Workplaces with AEDs and AED programs are helping protect everyone in the building, the entire time they are there.



With a well-implemented AED program and long-term AED management, SCA survival rates can increase from just 10% to over 50%.
